

UNDERGRADUATE RESIDENCY RECLASSIFICATION

Read on to learn about residency requirements, deadlines, and everything you need to know about residency for tuition purposes for undergraduate students here at the U.



UNDERGRADUATE...

The Undergraduate One Year Rule Policy applies to most students looking to reclassify their residency status at the University of Utah, and it is the most common policy undergraduate students use to reclassify as a resident for tuition purposes, after completing a minimum of 12 months in Utah.

THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET:

1 Residency Reclassification Application

2 Utah Domiciliary Ties: Utah driver's license, Utah voter registration, Utah vehicle registration (if the student owns a vehicle)



ONE YEAR RULE

3 Independent on Federal Taxes for most recent tax year (under 24 years and not married)

Proof of 12 months of continuous physical presence with no more than 29 days, either proven outside of Utah, or with no proof of physical presence, combined.



ADDITIONAL RESIDENCY POLICIES FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS*

In addition to the Undergraduate One Year Rule, there are additional residency reclassification policies a student may qualify for:

- Tax Dependent Student of Utah Resident Parents
- Marriage to a Utah Resident Spouse
- Move to Utah for Full Time Employment
- A Utah Resident who has been away for:
- School
- Ecclesiastical Service
- Government Volunteer Service
- Temporary Employment
- Extenuating Circumstances requiring relocation to Utah

RESIDENCY SEMESTER DEADLINES

SPRING

November 1 application submission deadline Application Deadline to guarantee a decision by the first day of the semester.

SUMMER

April 1 application submission deadline Application Deadline to guarantee a decision by the first day of the semester.

FALL

July 1 application submission deadline Application Deadline to guarantee a decision by the first day of the semester.
